SOP: Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Donning Guidelines for Staff

This SOP provides detailed **personal protective equipment (PPE) donning guidelines for staff**, including the proper selection, inspection, and correct sequence for wearing PPE to ensure maximum safety and hygiene. It emphasizes the importance of staff adherence to PPE protocols to prevent workplace contamination and exposure to hazards, thereby maintaining a safe and compliant working environment.

1. Purpose

To outline standard procedures for selecting, inspecting, and donning PPE to protect staff and maintain workplace safety and compliance.

2. Scope

This SOP applies to all staff members required to use PPE as part of their job duties in hazardous or contamination-prone work environments.

3. Responsibilities

5. PPE Inspection

- 1. Check PPE items for damages (tears, holes, cracks) before use.
- 2. Verify fit and integrity of all components.
- 3. Replace any defective or expired PPE immediately.

6. PPE Donning Sequence

- 1. Perform hand hygiene using soap/water or sanitizer.
- 2. Put on the gown or protective coverall and fasten securely.
- 3. Wear the mask or respirator; ensure proper fit and seal.
- 4. Don eye protection (goggles/face shield).
- 5. Put on gloves, ensuring cuff covers the gown sleeve.

7. Additional Guidelines

- Do not touch face or adjust PPE once donned, unless hands are clean.
- Replace and don new PPE before re-entering hazard zones if contamination is suspected.
- Dispose of or disinfect PPE as per facility protocols after use.
