# **Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)**

## **Code Blue and Emergency Response Procedures**

#### **Purpose:**

This SOP details the **Code Blue and Emergency Response Procedures**, outlining the necessary steps to be taken during a medical emergency within the facility. It includes the identification and activation of the Code Blue alert, immediate response protocols, roles and responsibilities of emergency response teams, communication strategies, and post-incident documentation and review. The purpose is to ensure a swift, coordinated, and effective response to medical emergencies to protect the health and safety of patients, staff, and visitors.

#### Scope:

This procedure applies to all staff, emergency response teams, and any individuals present within the facility.

## **Definitions:**

- Code Blue: An emergency situation involving cardiac or respiratory arrest requiring immediate resuscitation.
- Emergency Response Team (ERT): Designated personnel trained to respond to Code Blue events.

## Responsibilities:

- All Staff: Immediately report and initiate Code Blue when a medical emergency is identified.
- **Emergency Response Team:** Respond rapidly, initiate resuscitation protocols, and assume command of the emergency scene.
- Incident Commander: Lead the response, assign roles, and ensure effective communication and coordination.
- Recorder: Document all actions, times, and personnel involved during and after the emergency.

#### **Procedure:**

## 1. Identification of a Medical Emergency:

- Recognize signs of cardiac/respiratory arrest or life-threatening medical events.
- Ensure scene safety before approaching the victim.

#### 2. Activation of Code Blue:

- · Announce "Code Blue" loudly or activate the emergency alarm/call system as per facility protocol.
- Provide location details clearly (e.g., floor, room number).

## 3. Immediate Response:

- Start Basic Life Support (BLS) if trained (e.g., CPR, rescue breaths, AED).
- Send for emergency equipment (crash cart, AED).
- · Assigned staff should guide Emergency Response Team to the location.

## 4. Emergency Team Roles and Responsibilities:

- Team Leader: Oversee and direct resuscitation efforts.
- Airway Manager: Ensure airway patency and ventilation.
- o Medication Nurse: Prepare and administer emergency medications.
- o Compressor: Perform chest compressions.
- Recorder: Document events in real-time.

#### 5. Communication:

- Maintain clear, concise, and timely communication among all responders.
- o Inform relevant departments as required (e.g., security, administration).

#### 6. Post-Incident Procedures:

- o Debrief team members involved in the response.
- o Complete all documentation (incident forms, medical records).
- Review incident for opportunities for improvement and staff training needs.
