SOP Template: Preparation and Gathering of Cleaning Supplies and PPE

This SOP details the **preparation and gathering of cleaning supplies and PPE**, emphasizing the importance of selecting appropriate personal protective equipment and cleaning materials, organizing them efficiently for effective use, and ensuring all items are inspected and ready prior to cleaning operations. 1. Purpose

2. Scope

5. Procedure

- 1. Review Cleaning Assignment:
 - o Consult cleaning schedule/tasks to determine required supplies and PPE.
- 2. Select Appropriate PPE:
 - Choose gloves, masks, goggles, and attire based on cleaning chemicals and environment.
- 3. Gather Cleaning Supplies:
 - · Collect necessary supplies, materials, and equipment as per cleaning route or checklist.
- 4. Inspect Supplies and PPE:

- Replace disposable PPE after each use to prevent cross-contamination.
